## Introduction

In the Leadership Identity module, students are introduced to the idea that individuals as leaders have an identity that differentiates them from other leaders of the same caliber. They will be exposed to the different leadership styles and will understand the necessity of different leadership roles in an organization in order to have an effective working environment and group dynamic. Additionally, they will explore real life scenarios in which they can apply the leadership identity content they have learned and discuss the effects of sacrificing part of or the whole of one’s leadership identity.

## Objectives

1. Students will understand their “current” position within a team environment.
2. Students will consider what factors influence change within their leadership style.
3. Students will explore suitable leadership styles.
4. Students will be able to define necessary factors in a working system.
